### **Services Offered :**

1. Health Centre provides first aid service in the working hours.
2. Emergency service provides for all 24 hours by giving first aid and referred to the other multi speciality hospitals.
3. Provides health care service for the general ailments like
  - Fever
  - Common cold
  - Wheezing
  - Dyspnoea
  - Gastritis
  - Urinary tract infections

- Abscess
  - Scabies
  - Eye and Ear infection
  - Acute abdominal pain
  - Dysmenorrhoea
  - Acute gastro enteritis
4. Special services provides like
    - Dental care
    - Scaling
    - Filling
  5. Other services offered like
    - Conducting blood donation camps
    - Conducting health camps on life style diseases like
      - Diabetes
      - Hypertension
    - Awareness camps on epidemic disease like
      - Dengue
      - H1N1 Influenza (Swine Flu)
    - General awareness programmes on personal hygiene.
    - Preventive and curative service with Chloramphenicol drops for infective conjunctivitis for both boys and girls hostel students and staff.

### **Facilities :**

The following facilities are available at Health Centre

1. 24 hours vehicle service for emergency health care.
2. Psychology guidance and counseling provide by the psychologist twice a month.
3. Seven beds are available including one emergency bed.
4. In-patients services available in the working hours for observation from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
5. Oxygen cylinders and oxygen concentrators are available
6. Nebulizer for dyspnoeic patients.
7. Intra-Venus fluid infusions given for patients with Acute Gastro Enteritis, Fever with severe dehydration, etc.,
8. Dressing all the injuries and wounds.
9. Suturing done for the deep wounds.
10. Vaccination given against Tetanus with Inj.TT and Inj.ARV for dog bites.
